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What type of services do we offer?

- Athenry Family Services are flexible in the way we work with each family as the needs of all children and families are unique.
- We offer practical and emotional support and advice to parents around any problems parents may have in dealing with their children.



- We offer support by carrying out visits to the family home.
- We carry out individual and group work with children dealing with issues such as bereavement, anger management and self esteem.
- We carry out group work with parents addressing parenting issues.
- We link parents and children into other services such as educational or recreational courses, groups or after school activities.
- We liaise with other agencies and advocate for parents.
- We empower families to develop skills to deal with problems that may arise.

HOW CAN I REFER INTO ATHENRY FAMILY SERVICES?

- The service is provided to parents and children from 0 –18years.
- Families must live in the Athenry Primary Care Team area.
