Junior Cycle-School Report 2020

Thank you to all who provided feedback (students, parents and teaching staff), nearly two thirds of parents responded online. Having considered all the feedback we have decided on the following as the fairest means to generate a **School Certificate** for the Junior Cycle students. Remember that the students will also receive a **State Certificate** in relation to their participation in the Junior Cycle programme.

To ensure equity we are giving a balanced weighting, as set out in the table below, to work that was completed by students in advance of the closure of schools on 12 March 2020 and, in recognition of students' remarkable efforts with online learning, the work completed since that date and up until the end of this term.

**Predicted Results, these results are calculated using a student's previous results (Year 2 &3) and are based on an algorithm built and tested using over 10,000 previous Junior Certificate results nationwide. These results are unbiased and provide an estimate of what a student may have achieved in the Junior Certificate exam.

Teachers know their students best and they, the teachers, will consider project work, course work etc, to determine if the predicted results tally with their estimations and amend accordingly.

Individual subject vary considerably. Therefore, in relation to the end of year task there will be a variety of approaches which teachers will outline to their repetitive students. The final result will be arrived at as per the table above.
